## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. IP 5-year olds will play 3 x 20 minute ½ ice games + 5 minute warm-up  
IP 6-year olds will play 3 x 50 minute ½ ice games + 5 minute warm-up
2. A maximum of 3 games may be played depending on the total number of teams participating.
3. Based on the schedule, players will be allocated change rooms by arena based on Fun Day schedule.
4. Each team will consist of approximately 15 players.
5. 6 Year old teams must dress one player in full goalie equipment.
6. Teams should arrive at the arena, a **minimum of 45** minutes before their game is scheduled to begin.
7. Each association will be responsible for adhering to the age guidelines for the first and second year IP.
8. Coaches are responsible for line changes. The timekeeper will buzz the clock every two 2:00 minutes, to indicate the line change.
9. The clock will run for the duration of the game. After a goal is scored the face off returns to centre ice of your respective "rink".
10. There will be ten minutes between games to allow for flooding. Players must be dressed and all players at the gate ready to get on the ice when the flooding is complete.
11. NOTE: ALL ASSOCIATIONS WILL SHARE DRESSING ROOMS - SECURITY IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH ASSOCIATION - CMHA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.
12. Each association will be responsible for providing staff as officials for the events at all times. The Staff shall consist of: two bench coaches, one on-ice coach, and one trainer. The support of volunteers from each association to help run the event is important to the success of the event. Volunteers from outside associations who wish to help out should report to the Volunteer station 20 minutes before game time.
13. Each player will receive a refreshment after each game and a memento of their participation within the Cumberland Minor Hockey House League Association IP Fun Days.
14. No score will be kept. This is not a competitive event. Our objective for this event is to support the objective of Hockey Canada, to ensure that the first goal of hockey is having fun.
15. As part of our safety program for that day, spectators will not be allowed on the ice surface. Volunteers will be monitoring the arena and corridors to ensure that players, family and friends enjoy a safe and fun time while they are with us.
16. Only one parent or guardian is to accompany the child to the dressing room - other family members and friends should go directly to the spectator/seating area of the arena.
